January 8-9-10 of '09, Barns & Noble in Glendora will donate 90% of their profits to Eye-DAS.

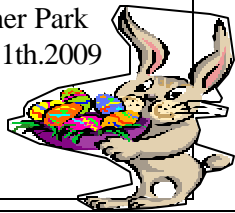

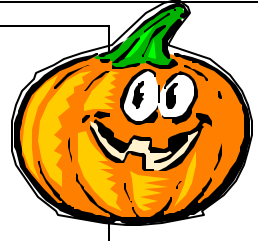

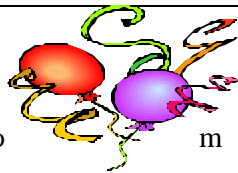
